- 1. Amend the "junk yard" definition on page 12 of present land use code book to add a "C" to say "As defined above, one junk vehicle is permitted per property"
- 2. The idea of adding provisions on "density" on a lot, possibly to limit the number of accessory buildings.
- 3. To require new property owners to update/inspect their septic systems. While the Codes officer can inspect any system deemed necessary there is some benefit in having this put into place through the Certificate of Occupancy process.
- 4. Updating the subdivision guidelines.

Mary and the Planning Board are interested in the Town Boards thoughts on the potential changes. Mary said she will keep the Town Board updated.
