**Mr. Wilt** sent the board members information from Schnabel the engineers working on the Piseco Lake Dam project. They would like to meet with the board to talk about the data and how it relates to the lake. They would also like to talk about upgrading the existing dam or putting in a new dam. He will schedule a meeting with them around the end of February or early March.

#### **Committee reports:**

**Snowmobile trails & buildings: Mrs. Grier** reported the trails are very rough as there isn't enough snow to groom. She had nothing on buildings.

Lake Dam: Mrs. Rudes had nothing other than the previous discussion.

**Mr. Wilt** reported he talked with the town lawyer about the revised septic law and feels that it would be better to wait until the summer residents are here. The board decided to do it in July and will schedule a public hearing for July 13<sup>th</sup>, 2020. The board will also be looking into a change in the building permits maybe adding roof replacements, density issues as well.

**Mr. LaScola** asked about charging for construction debris at the transfer station. He said that Lake Pleasant's system doesn't really fit what we need. He suggested charging anything over 250 lbs. for a private individual. Anything under that would be free. Contractors would be different. Mrs. Rudes suggested just starting with contractors to see what it would take to implement it. The board will get it ready and sent out a notice with the Town's annual letter they send out.

**Mr. LaScola** reported the Town has gotten the ok on the JIF for the new highway garage from the APA. They also said it is a Town project and the APA has no jurisdiction.
