Mrs. Rudes inquired about getting the service road at the far end of the airport covered with a material that is easier to walk on, because the stones that are on it now are hard to walk on. Mr. Small suggested if the bid for the runway grant that the millings from the runway could be put down on it which would be almost like paving it.
