# **COMMITTEE REPORTS:**

**SNOWMOBILE TRAILS**: Jacqui Grier was absent. Supervisor Rhodes and Superintendent Small discussed purchasing tracks for the Tucker groomer.

<u>TOWN BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS</u>- Doug Stobo asked about the painting of the Old Town Garage. Supervisor Rhodes stated that the Highway Department has been very busy and probably will not get to the painting this year.

**RECREATION, WEBSITE & CAMPSITE**: Christy Wilt is working on a check off cleaning list for the Community Hall for renters. The Hall will be checked after being used.

**LAKE/DAM/CEMETERY:** Johnny Rajca stated people had told him how nice the new flags looked. He in turn thanked Craig for having flags put up. A discussion followed regarding the lake level and how the storms had affected when the boards were taken out of the dam and put back in for regulation of the level. Bill Hotaling has questions regarding the dam. Discussion followed.

**CODES AND ZONING**: Mel LaScola discussed the ZBA meeting. The form for a variance was discussed and if more information should be included on the form. The possible change to the form will be brought before the Planning Board at their next meeting. Supervisor Rhodes reported that Brad Parslow is now a Certified Building Inspector and will be assisting Mel with future projects. Congratulations Brad.

**HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENT:** Craig Small reported that the Highway Department has been doing a lot of work in Higgins Bay ditching, they will continue to the Wild Road and the Powley Road. Chris asked Craig to investigate a specific driveway in Higgins Bay for possible problems.

<u>AIRPORT AND FINANCE:</u> Supervisor Rhodes discussed the fuel pump at the airport. It has had some difficulty pumping. Due to its age, it may be difficult to repair. He reported that the Wakely Dam Race will be on Saturday July 27<sup>th</sup> and they will set up for the race on Friday at the Airport.
