Zoning Officer Mel LaScola had no new business to discuss.

Many suggestions were brought to this meeting concerning modifying the zoning codes on signs. It was unanimously agreed that the changes need to lean towards making the codes business friendly.

Ken Kull made many suggestions that were well received concerning the change and/or wording of parts of code 6.020 General Standards and Regulations A, B, C, D & E, and code 6.040 Residential, Home Occupations & Other Non-Business Uses A.

Mike Cullen stressed making the codes business friendly and possibly getting input from Arietta businesses and realtors.

Mel wanted the Planning Board to consider implementing a time span for any Temporary signs.

A permit system was suggested although this would mean more paperwork for Mel.

There is much more discussion needed until an agreement to all changes can be made.

Chairman Greiner asked everyone to do more research and more discussion will follow at the December meeting.

Once changes are agreed on, they will have to be presented to the Town Supervisor to bring to the Town Board. It will also have to go to the APA.

A motion to adjourn was made by Mike Cullen. Seconded by Ken Kull. All were in favor 4 - 0.
