COMMITTEES:

<u>SNOWMOBILE TRAILS</u>: Jacqui Grier reported that the Town of Morehouse would like to join the snowmobile club. Discussion followed.

<u>RECREATION/WEBSITE/CAMPSITE</u>: Christy Wilt reported that she had spoken to Allison Gaddy from the Lake Champlain Lake George Regional Planning Board regarding photos of the Community Hall, Museum, and property behind these sites. She is working on a grant for Arietta.

FINANCE/AIRPORT/INTERNAL MANAGEMENT/INSURANCE:

Chris Rhodes reported that the lake level is down by twelve inches. The boards will be taken out of the dam this week. He led a discussion on cost of various insurances for the town. The Preliminary Budget was filed with the Town Clerk on September 29,2025

<u>HIGHWAY SUPERINTENDENTS REPORT</u>: Craig Small reported that the new siding on the Lower Equipment Garage will be finished this week. He explained to the board various mechanical problems that he had been managing this last month. The Highway Department rented a loader until the town's loader is fixed. He stated that the cable that holds the buoys at the spillway had broken and needed to be replaced.

<u>CODES AND ZONING</u>: Mel Lascola reported to the board that a complaint he had received regarding "junk vehicles" on a property owners' yard, the owner was sent a registered letter with returned receipt. Mel has not received the receipt or heard from the owner. There will be a meeting on 10/13/2025 for a variance.

OLD BUSINESS: There will be a budget workshop on 10/7/2025 at 500 p.m. at Piseco School Meeting Room.

<u>NEW BUSINESS</u>: Chris Rhodes explained that Hamilton County is going to start a County Wide Short Term Rental Registry. The board all agreed to rescind the Town Local Law regarding the short-term rentals. This resolution will be brought to the meeting 10/7/25 for formal vote.
