PROPOSED LOCAL LAW NO. 2 OF 2026
State of New York
Town of Arietta

A LOCAL LAW OVERRIDING THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR THE TOWN OF ARIETTA FOR 2027 BUDGET AND AUTHORIZING THE ADOPTION BY THE TOWN OF ARIETTA OF A BUDGET FOR 2027 THAT REQUIRES A TAX LEVY THAT IS GREATER THAN THE TAX LEVY LIMIT FOR THE 2027 FISCAL YEAR

BE IT ENACTED by the Town of Arietta Town Board as follows:

Section 1. **Title:** This Local law shall be known as “Town of Arietta Responsible Budgeting Law of 2027”.

Section 2. **Declaration of Intent:** The intention of this local law is to comply with the requirements of General Municipal Law Section 3-c (5) prior to adopting the 2027 Town of Arietta Budget. The slow recovery of the national, state, and local economies from the most recent recession and the continued financial obligations imposed on the Town by the State in the form of mandated government activities not fully funded by the State are conditions beyond the control of Town government. Notwithstanding these circumstances, the Town will need to provide services in 2027, in addition to those mandated by the State, which are important to our citizens. After serious and sustained efforts to minimize the amount of the tax levy and to project the tax levy limit for the Town of Arietta for 2027, it is clear that a responsible budget for 2027 will require a tax levy that will be greater than the tax levy limit calculated pursuant to applicable State Law.

Section 3. **Budget Authorization:** The Town Board hereby overrides the tax levy limit for the Town of Arietta for 2027 and authorizes the Town of Arietta, after completing all required procedures for the adoption of a budget, to adopt a budget for 2027 that requires a tax levy that is greater than the tax levy limit calculated for 2027 pursuant to Section 3-c of the General Municipal Law.

Section 4. **Severability:** If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, phrase, or other portion of this Local Law is for any reason declared unconstitutional or invalid, in whole or in part, by any court of competent jurisdiction, such portion shall be deemed severable and such unconstitutionality or invalidation shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this law, which remaining portions shall remain in full force and effect.

Section 5. **Effective Date:** This local law shall take effect upon the date on which a certified copy of this Local Law is filed in the office of the Secretary of State pursuant to section 27 of the Municipal Home Rule Law.

The Town of Arietta is seeking proposals to provide and install a point-of-sale credit card terminal for the fuel dispenser at Piseco Airport.

The installation location is the "SRE" Building Gas Dispenser, 39 Airport Rd. Piseco, NY 12139

Specifications-

- Credit Card reader terminal with software and support to work with our existing single product/single hose system.
- Please list recurring fees (software support and any other fees that may apply).
- Provide and install all the materials, parts, and equipment needed for a fully operational system to meet or exceed all NEC and local code requirements, test the system, and provide training for Town personnel.
- Existing System- The existing dispenser is a Bennett 3000 series with 210 electronics.
- The Existing Card Reader is from Fuel Force/ Multi Force, Retail Exacta Controller, with RS485 communication wiring. It has a phone line connection to our Heartland payment system.

Proposals-

- Proposals shall be submitted to the Town of Arietta Supervisor, PO Box 37, Piseco, NY 12139, or by email to toa@townofarietta.gov, no later than October 5, 2026, at 3:00 pm.
- Proposals meeting minimum specifications will be presented to the Town of Arietta Board at the October 5th, 2026, Town Board meeting at 5:00 pm.

-The Town will review proposals based on compliance with the specifications, total cost including recurring fees, installation approach, timeline, warranty or support terms, and the proposer's experience with fuel dispensing payment systems.

-Award of any proposal shall be contingent on meeting or exceeding the specifications described.

-All proposals shall include a detailed breakdown of all work and materials to be provided and installed.

-Site inspections are highly recommended and can be scheduled by contacting the Town of Arietta supervisor.

The Town of Arietta has the right to refuse any bid.
