Mr. Wilt opened the Public Hearing for the Local Law #1 of the year 2014 “The Town of Arietta Aquatic Invasive Species Prevention Law”.

**Bryan Rudes** of the Piseco Lake Association thanked the Town Board for making this Local Law to help keep Aquatic Invasive Species out of Town waters. He said that DEC has said that there is already Spiny Fleas in Piseco Lake. He also would like to see DEC put people at their boat launches to monitor all boats being put in Piseco Lake. He said he sent a letter to the Supervisor stating their desires. Mr. Wilt said that he will be setting up a meeting with DEC and other lake associations to talk about having someone at all boat launches to monitor boats. Mr. Rudes also said that there will be training held to teach people how to monitor the boats and what to look for. Gene Scott echoed everything Mr. Rudes said and he said that a lot of money is spent trying to get rid of these problems and what needs to be done is to keep them out of our lakes.
